

Entry Rules



1. Each team must fill out an entry form, maximum of 4 people per team.
2. Entry fee is \$50 per community team; \$25 per student team.
3. Entries must be submitted by March 20.
4. Chili recipes must be typed out on 8.5" x 11" paper.
5. Applicants are required to purchase ingredients and make one full pot (at least 4 quarts) of chili off-site using proper sanitary cooking standards.
6. Applicants must supply their own crock pot or hot plate (if possible*).
7. Applicants are required to set up and be prepared to serve beginning at 11:00 a.m.
8. Cooks must wear food handling gloves that will be provided by the Rotary Club.
9. All cooks will be required to taste their own chili in the presence of one of the judges prior to judging.
10. Trash cans, tables, chairs, serving ladles, bowls, spoons, and napkins will be provided to each applicant.
11. Judging will take place at 12:00 noon and awards will be presented at 2:00 p.m.
12. At least one member of the cooking team must be present to accept award.
13. All applicants are responsible for cleaning their area.
14. **JUDGING CRITERIA**
 - Aroma
 - Texture
 - Flavor
 - Heat
 - Uniqueness
15. **REWARDS** are as follow:
 - 1st place:** "Cheesy Chili" trophy and prizes valued at \$300
 - 2nd place:** "Cheesy Chili" trophy and prizes valued at \$200
 - 3rd place:** "Cheesy Chili" trophy and prizes valued at \$100
 - People's Choice** (voted on by all ticket holders): Best of Show award
